

We love hearing little ones in God's house but if you feel like your child needs a moment there are speakers to hear the service as well as books and toys in the entryway


Our guest register is located in the entryway. Please leave us a record of your visit and we will be glad to supply you with more information about our church.

THE WORD

FIRST READING

Acts 11:1-18

The apostles and brothers throughout Judea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God. ²When Peter went up to Jerusalem, those who insisted on circumcision criticized him, ³saying, “You went to visit men who were uncircumcised and ate with them!” ⁴So Peter began to explain everything to them, point by point. He said, ⁵“I was in the city of Joppa praying, and in a trance I saw a vision in which an object like a large sheet was let down from heaven by its four corners. It came right to me. ⁶When I inspected it very carefully, I saw four-footed animals of the earth, wild beasts, reptiles, and birds of the air. ⁷I also heard a voice telling me, ‘Get up, Peter! Kill and eat!’ ⁸“But I replied, ‘Certainly not, Lord, for nothing impure or unclean has ever entered my mouth.’ ⁹“A voice spoke from heaven a second time: ‘What God has made clean, you must not continue to call unclean.’ ¹⁰This happened three times, and then everything was pulled up into

heaven again. ¹¹“At that very moment, three men who had been sent to me from Caesarea arrived at the house where we were. ¹²The Spirit told me to go with them without any hesitation. These six brothers also accompanied me, and we entered the man’s house. ¹³He told us how he saw an angel standing in his house and saying, ‘Send to Joppa and call for Simon, the one called Peter. ¹⁴He will speak words to you by which you and all your household will be saved.’ ¹⁵“As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit came down on them, just as he came down on us at the beginning. ¹⁶Then I remembered how the Lord had said, ‘John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.’ ¹⁷So if God gave them the same gift as he gave us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I to try to stand in God’s way?” ¹⁸When they heard these things, they had no further objections, and they praised God, saying, “So then, God has granted repentance that results in life also to the Gentiles!”

SECOND READING

1 Corinthians 13:1-13

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. ²If I have the gift of prophecy and know all the mysteries and have all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. ³If I give away everything I own, and if I give up my body that I may be burned but do not have love, I gain nothing. ⁴Love is patient. Love is kind. Love does not envy. It does not brag. It is not arrogant. ⁵It does not behave indecently. It is not selfish. It is not irritable. It does not keep a record of wrongs. ⁶It does not rejoice over unrighteousness but rejoices with the truth. ⁷It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. ⁸Love never comes to an end. But if there are prophetic gifts, they will be done away with; if tongues, they will cease; if knowledge, it will be done away with. ⁹For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part, ¹⁰but when that which is complete has come, that which is partial will be done away with. ¹¹When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put away childish things. ¹²Now we see indirectly using a mirror, but then we will see face to face. Now I know in part, but then I will know fully, just as I was fully known. ¹³So now these three remain: faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love.

NICENE CREED

Keeping in mind our lesson from 1 Corinthians 13:1-13, we see we can do all the nice things possible for the people of the world, but they can be meaningless. We can speak all the wise words to the people around us, but they could be just noise. We could give huge sums of money to the church, and it could be simply an empty gesture. That would be if we do not do those things out of love for God who first loved us. Yet when we display love for God and for our neighbor in our actions, our words, and our stewardship of all that God has given us, that is a beautiful life.

PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

L: Lord Jesus, we are filled with joy as we consider who you are and what you have done for us. You have given us real life, eternal life, because you are life itself and have united us with you through faith. You have given us words and knowledge and wisdom on which we can always rely because they are your truth, and you will never change. You have rescued us from aimless and wasted wandering and revealed yourself as the way to the Father.

C: **Keep us in your life and light and truth, the life, light, and truth that we find in your birth, in your ministry, in your cross, and in your resurrection and ascension. Help us to always remember all aspects of your life and work so that in every circumstance of our lives we will find reason to sing your praises.**

L: We praise you, O Savior, that you have called us to be your own, that you have opened our eyes to see and our hearts to believe that you are the promised Messiah. Not only have you called us to faith, you have also called us to service. You have not rejected us because of our faults and failings but blessed us with your Spirit that we might proclaim your glory to our neighborhoods and to the nations.

C: **Cause us to delight in the work you give us to do so that others, through us, will be led to marvel at your mercy and join with us in worshipping you.**

L: Lord of Love, you prophesied that the love of many would grow cold as we lived in the end times. We see that prophecy fulfilled in many ways in the world today: parents who do not

treasure their children and children who do not treasure their parents; those who seek to destroy those with whom they disagree rather than seeing them as valued individuals.

C: Do not let us be seduced or ensnared by their attitudes. Keep alive in us your love that we may be your salt and light in the world. Enable us to proclaim you so that they may be transformed by your love. Rebuild and restore those who have suffered the world's lack of love.

L: Heavenly Father, you cause your sun to rise on the evil and the good, and send your rain upon the righteous and unrighteous, we bring before you our petition that you would send restoring moisture to the areas of our country that are experiencing severe drought.

C: We know that we do not deserve your mercy, nor can we demand that you shower your goodness on us. We also know that there will be too many who do not acknowledge you as the source of what is good and thank you for it. Nevertheless grant that which only you can supply that the earth may drink in of your goodness and that there may be blessing for those for whom your Son has died.

L: Hear us, Lord, as we bring you our private petitions.

L: May the words of our mouths and the meditations of our hearts be acceptable as we pray that which you have taught us:

LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
